A BRIEF INTRODUCTION OF OUR CHAMBER AND BENEFITS / FACILITIES / SERVICES AVAILABLE TO MEMBERS & NON MEMBERS

I. Establishment :

Our Chamber i.e. Kanara Chamber of Commerce & Industry, Mangalore, is a District level Chamber. It was established under Section 26 of the Indian Companies Act, 1913 on the 20th December, 1940. [Subsequently governed under Section 25 of the Companies Act, 1956 and currently under Section 8 of the Companies Act - 2013].

II. Objects :

Objects for which this Chamber was established as set out in the Memorandum of Association are as under:

1. To promote and protect the trade, commerce and manufactures of India and in particular of the District of Dakshina Kannada, to study the general commercial interests of India or any part thereof and the interests of persons engaged therein.
2. To consider all questions connected with trade, commerce and manufactures and to collect and circulate statistics and other informations relating thereto.
3. To promote or oppose proposed legislative and other measures affecting trade, commerce and manufactures.
4. To adjust controversies between members of the Association, to arbitrate in the settlement of disputes arising out of commercial transactions between parties willing or agreeing to abide by the judgement and decision of the Association.
5. To establish just and equitable principles in trade.
6. To form a code or codes of practice to simplify and facilitate the transaction of business and to maintain uniformity in rules, regulations and usages of trade.
7. To communicate with Chambers of Commerce and other Mercantile and public bodies throughout the world and concert and promote measures for the protection of trade, commerce and manufacturers and persons engaged therein.
8. To contribute to and conduct, and to provide premises and other facilities for holding and conducting, sales of property, brokerage or commercial transactions, meetings of creditors, companies or Arbitrators, and other like matters.

9. To establish and conduct in or in connection with any building or room erected, provided, regulated or maintained by the Association for the purposes aforesaid, a restaurant and / or club for the use of the members of the Association and others resorting to such building or room for the negotiation or transaction of business, and to afford all the usual advantages, privileges and conveniences of a club.

Note:- 1. It is open to Members to attempt on their individual capacity or collectively alongwith other members at their best for achieving these objects, to rise up to the highest position of President to lead the Chamber for achieving the objects on their leadership capability.

2. Chamber services and facilities are available at cost –
To Members at Member rate & To Non-Members at double the rate applicable to Members.

III. Who can become a Member of KCCI: Merchants, Bankers, Ship-owners, Representatives of Commercial, Railway and Insurance companies, Brokers and Persons engaged in Commerce, Agriculture, Mining or Manufacture and Persons engaged in or connected with Art, Science, Literature or Law shall be eligible for Membership. Provided that such persons or individuals do generally reside in the geographical area comprising of the District of Dakshina Kannada before its bifurcation in the year 1997 and, in the case of firm, association, company or corporation, it has a place of business or a branch office within the limits of the said area.

IV. Classes and Categories of Membership:

There are three Classes and five categories of Membership:

- 1) Life Members
- 2) Ordinary Members – i.e. Yearly renewable in the month of April and
- 3) Honorary Members

Categories:

(i) Individuals / Proprietors/Professionals (ii) Partnership firms (iii) Co-operative Societies (iv) Associations (v) Companies (Private and Public Limited) functioning within the geographical jurisdiction of undivided i.e. erstwhile Dakshina Kannada District are eligible to enroll as Members of our Chamber.

Current Strength of Membership: At present the strength of Membership of KCCI is 1300 plus including 489 Life Members and one Honorary Member.

Scope to Members: There is no limit to Members to reach any position in KCCI to achieve its objects depending on their skill, knowledge, active participation and leadership quality.
